Code of Conduct for Adult Players

I understand that I am a member of Kensington Dragons FC, an FA Charter Standard Club, and agree to behave in such a way that I do not bring the Club into disrepute. Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for players at all times.

On and off the field, I will:

- Adhere to the Laws of the Game
- Display and promote high standards of behaviour
- Promote Fair Play
- Always respect the match official's decisions
- Never engage in public criticism of the match officials
- Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Never engage in bullying, intimidation or harassment
- Speak to my team-mates, the opposition and my coach/manager with respect.
- Remember we all make mistakes.
- Win or lose with dignity. Shake hands with the opposing team and the referee at the end of every game.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA.

I may:

- Be required to apologise to team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a warning from the coach
- Receive a written warning from the club committee
- Be required to attend an FA education course
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Not be selected for the team
- Be required to serve a suspension
- Be fined
- Be required to leave the club.

In addition:

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club

I understand that it is important that I adhere to any dress code and am on time with clean kit for training and matches. If I am going to be late for training or unavailable then it is my sole responsibility to inform either the manager or coach as soon as possible. I understand that if I am late for a game/training then I face the possibility of being deselected for match day duties or not being allowed to participate in training.

I will pay my subscriptions as and when they are due. I understand that if I fail to pay my subscriptions I could be deselected for match day duties, and my registration placed on hold meaning that I will not be able to play for another club until such time as I have paid my subscriptions or given written permission by the club to play for another club (this will be reported to the County FA)

I will report any injuries to my coach / team manager/physio as soon as possible. I know that I am expected to stretch and warm up before each game/training session and to warm down at the end.

Should I wish to cease playing for Kensington Dragons then I will inform the Manager and the Director of Football in writing and ensure that all outstanding subscriptions and fines are paid up to date before the club will agree to my release.
